

EXTRAMURAL ART CLASSES AT MICHAEL OAK 2nd TERM 2026

The much-loved art classes continue to be held at Michael Oak on (times below) and are now part of the programme offered by the school. The venue is a lovely room in one of the high school houses, facing the garden. Pupils can come to the room for art straight after school or other extramural activities, and wait under guidance (eat their lunch, read or draw), or join the art class. They may arrive a little late after class or other extramurals if needed.

The emphasis is on fostering creativity, self-esteem and enjoyment of art, while learning techniques and a sense of aesthetics. Generally, on offer are a variety of media, themes, and 2-D as well as 3-D projects, including those about the natural environment, and inspired by South African, African and other artists, as well as current local exhibitions.



Projects for the 2nd term: These will be chosen from clay sculptures; sketching and painting in the greenbelt and garden; top-down view pastel outdoor drawings on textured board; ink painting or collages using etching, natural objects, inks, etc; portraits and landscapes using artist Maggie Loubser's artworks to inspire in a current way; preparation for painting on canvas; paper mâché artworks; chalk pastel and charcoal work (see illustrations). Projects are age appropriate, with interesting introductions. Do put in requests.

Days and times, 2nd term's classes (starts 17th, or 24th April if needed)

- Friday 12.50pm – 1.45 pm; can arrive at 1pm (Kindergarten, Classes 1 and 2), depending on venue
- Friday 1.45pm – 2.45pm (Kindergarten, Classes 1 to 4), depending on venue
- Friday 2.45pm - 3.45pm (Classes 5, 6 ,7 or higher; also Classes 1 to 4 if needed)

Also in Constantia (off Brommersvlei Road) for all age groups on Thursday mornings and Saturday morning. Fees include materials and firing, and are R1290 per term.
